The Sheth J. N. Paliwala Commerce College Science & Arts College, Pali-sudhagad Was established in June,1989. The College is permanently Affiliated to the University of Mumbai and was reaccredited by NAAC with B Grade CGPA 2.48 in July. 2013

The College offers degree courses in Commerce, Science & Arts. Students qualifying in H.S.C. examination are eligible for the admission to the three year degree course.

ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION :

1. Student qualifying in H.S.C. examination can apply for admission to three year degree course in his respective faculty. Student qualifying H.S.C. examination with commerce or science can take admission for B.A. degree.
2. Students qualifying in the F.Y.B.A. / F.Y.B.Com./ F.Y.B.Sc.(old course) are eligible for Admission for new Coursein respective stream with the prior permission of the principal.



3. Students from the colleges affiliated to any University, other than University of Mumbai must produce provisional certificate of eligibility from the University of Mumbai Admission without provisional certificate of eligibility for such students is not allowed.
4. Students from colleges affiliated to University of Mumbai must produce No Objection Certificate from the college last attended at the time of admission

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION :

1. At the time of admission, the student must remain present in the college office.
2. The students are required to preserve the cash receipts issued by the college office. Deposit and caution Money will not be refunded without the cash receipts.

5. Xerox copy of school Leaving certificate & Adhar Card.
6. If Transferred from other district, transfer Certificate issued by the District Social Welfare.
7. Certificate from the Rector if staying in hostel.
8. Certificate of scholarship from the principal if coming from other college.
9. One Passport size photograph.
10. Married female student must enclose the income certificate of her husband.
11. Student who failed in the last examination should submit fresh application.

STATE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE STUDENTS BELONGING TO OTHER BACKWAR CLASS (O.B.C)

5. Xerox copy of school Leaving certificate.
6. If Transferred from other district, transfer Certificate issued by the District Social Welfare.



7. Certificate from the Rector if staying in hostel.
8. Certificate of scholarship from the principal if Coming from other collrege.
9. One passport sixe photograph.
10. Married female student must enclose the income certificate of her husband.
11. Student who failed in the last examination should submit fresh application.

SCHOLARSHIP FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S FUND & STUDENT WELFARE FUND

For poor and deserving students a scholarship from the Principla's fund and student welfare is also available. The Students should apply to the principal before 30th August in the prescribed format.

FEE CONCESSIONS

1. ECONOMICALLY BACKGROUND CLASS (E.B.C.)

Students whose parent's annual income int the year 01-04-2020 to 31-03-2020 is below Rs.1,00,000/- can have the benefit of this fee concession. The student must submit the prescribed form and income certificate issued by compeity at the time of admission

2. PRIMARY TEACHER'S WARD :

The wards of primary teachers working in granted schools only are eligible. The ward of retierd primary teacher is not eligible for this fee concessions. The certificate from the Education officer is essential. The Certificate should be submitted at the time of admission.

3. WARDS OF EX-SERVICEMEN :

The son/ daughter/widow of ex-serviceman are eligible for this fee concessions. The applications should be submitted at the time of admission with a certificate issued by the collector.

4. CHHATRAPATI SHAHU MAHARAJ SCHOLARSHIP :

The student from open category but financially weaker, having good academic record and fulfilling the conditions laid down by the government of Maharashtra can apply for this scholarship.

5. SCHOLARSHIPS FROM PRINCIPAL'S ASSOCIATION :

The students who are below poverty line can apply for this scholarship.

6. ZEELA PARISHAD CESS FUND:

Students below poverty line / economically backward can apply for this scholarship.

7. UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS:

Students belonging to weaker section of society and having good academic / non academic record can apply for this scholarship.

8. POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MINORITY STUDENTS:

Students from minority category can apply for this scholarship.



REFUND OF FEES :

0.2859 Refund of tuition, development and all other fees after cancellation of admissions :

The candidates who have taken admission in aided and unaided courses conducted by the affiliated colleges, and in recognized institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before the 30th day after the date of cancellation. The fee component out of all fee in the column no(ii), (iii) & (iv) includes the following item in the deductions : Tuition fee (of the first term only), Laboratory fee, Library fee, gymkhana fee, other fees, Extra curricular activities fee, Student's Welfare Fund, Utility fee, Development fee, Computer practical fee and E- Charges.
3. In addition to above, in case of cancellation of admission after 31st August, Vice Chancellor's fund, project fee, University sports and cultural activities and group insurance is also included.



IDENTITY CARD :

Identity card is issued to every bonafied student of the college. Every student must wear the Identity card in the college premises and should produce in when asked for.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION :

For the science classes, the medium of instruction is English. The Medium of instruction for Arts and Commerce classes is Marathi. However, the subjects in Arts and Commerce can be taught in english, provided sufficient number of students opt for english.

LIBRARY :

The college library will remain open on all the working days from 08.30 a.m. to 04.30 p.m. The library is rich in books, with professional, scientific and literary journals and periodicals, reference books, newspaper and other reading material, Reading room facility is available in the college library. The supervised night study room is made available one month prior to the date of commencement of the examination. It is open upto 10.30 p.m.

Library has a book bank scheme for the S.C. students interested in availing the book bank facility should contact the librarian for additional information. Free internet access is provided to the students in the library.

LIBRARY RULES :

1. Complete silence should be observed in the library and the reading room.
2. Pencil or ink marking or mutilating the books in any way will be treated as violation of library discipline. Student found guilty of this act will have to replace the old book by a new copy.
3. Without presenting the identity card, books will not be issued.
4. Only one books will be issued to the student at a time. The book will be issued for a period of seven days. After seven days a fine of Rs. 1/- daily will be charged.
5. Magazines or periodicals are not to be taken out of the reading room.
6. The principal reserves the right to alternation in the library rules as and when required.

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES :

National Service Scheme : " Not Me But You" :

The College is having very active National Service Scheme Unit. Total strength allocated to our college for N.S.S. is 300. Leadership development, overall personality development of the student, skill development, work for the society, social service are the main objective of this scheme. A student can be enrolled in N.S.S. in the second year of the college. Student should complete 240 work hours in the community and attend one seven days special residential camp during two years. Such students will get benefit of 10 grace marks and a volunteership certificate. interested students should contact the N.S.S. program officer for their enrollment in N.S.S.



DEPARTMENT OF LIFELONG LEARNING & EXTENSION :

"Reach to unreached". This is another activity run by the college. Every year students are enrolled under this activity. Projects are given to the student, which they are supposed to complete during the year. Projects like status of woman in society, Carrier project, population education club were undertaken during last year. In each project 25 students are enrolled. They are guided by a student manager and extension work teacher. For the student manager and the extension work teacher, the University organizes training programs in both semester. UDDAN is the annual competition held by the department. Students successfully completing the project get benefit of 10 grace marks.
